A child is registered with the School upon receipt of a completed application form accompanied by a registration fee of € 200 (€215 if transferred from outside the Netherlands) Please note the registration fee is non-refundable, covering administrative costs and assessment.

THE APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE THAT THERE WILL BE A PLACE FOR THE CHILD OR THAT AN AVAILABLE PLACE WILL BE OFFERED.

After application, if a vacancy exists and the child is considered to benefit from the academic program offered at our school, a place will be offered in the form of a letter to the parent. The parent must reply to the School accepting the place. The documents needed for each child before entry. (See below)

- **completed registration form and fee.**
- **copy of the information pages of the child's passport or copy of the child's birth certificate.**
- **copy of registration document confirming residency in Holland.**  
**(Uittreksel uit Gemeentelijke Basisadministratie (GBA))**
- **completed emergency contact section on the registration form.**

Children must be 3 before they can be admitted to group 0. Group 1 is intended for children who reach the age of 4 by October 1<sup>st</sup> 2009. Children **must** be able to use the bathroom before admission to Group 0 can be considered and not still wearing nappies.

Children qualify for places at Elckerlyc International School if they are:

- **Children from other countries who have been educated in English and who will only be spending a few years in The Netherlands and who require a continuous English education.**
  - **Children from other countries who have been educated in English and who need transitional English-to -Dutch education to prepare them for future education within the Dutch school system.**
  - **Children living in The Netherlands who will be moving to another country where their subsequent education will be in English.**
- In case of a waiting list for entry into Group 1 students of Group 0 will have priority.
  - Where a child does not start Group 0 at the beginning of the academic year a place cannot be guaranteed for a later start date.
  - The registration fee of €200 only has to be paid on first entrance to the school (Group 0 – 7).
  - Parents need to sign the financial agreement attached to the registration form in order for their child(ren) to be officially registered as students of our school.
  - Withdrawal of a student with a return of fees can only happen when the school has received 2 months notice in writing. In all other cases one month's extra fees will be charged.
  - Parents will be billed. Failure to pay on time will result in one reminder where after the place will be offered to the next child on the waiting list.
  - Children who increase sessions part way through a month will be charged for the whole month.

 Afternoon sessions 12.45– 14.45 (Monday, Tuesday and Thursday)

Doors open at 8.15 am.

Elckerlyc is a diverse community. We do not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, religion, national origin or sex in the selection of students. We actively seek diversity in our student body.

Please note the following points:

1. No discounts will be given in the case of more than one child from the same family attending the International Section of the school.
2. If a child begins attending the school at a date other than the official start of the academic year in August/September, the school fee will be calculated pro rata + one month.
3. Parents are requested to pay the school fee within the time set on the invoice. Should this not be convenient, the fee can be paid in two instalments.
4. School fees are calculated on a ten month basis, plus one month when a child leaves school.

I understand and agree that placement is probationary until the school decides otherwise. We wish to enrol our child(ren) at the International Department of Elckerlyc. We have read the school's prospectus and understand the admission regulations that govern enrolment. The information submitted is accurate to the best of our knowledge and we see no reason why our child should not be able to follow the education program offered by the school. We accept that the school reserves the right to refuse admission to students whom they feel cannot benefit from the program being offered.
